

#### **Competition Rules**

Concours d'Etat is about the cleanliness and condition of a car. Originality or authenticity is not judged. The underside of the car will also not be judged.

#### 1 ORGANISATION

Judging for d'Etat entrants will be held at the time and location stipulated by the Club Committee. Participating Vehicles must be in place by the stipulated time. Late arrivals may be penalised.

#### 2 RULES FOR ENTRANTS

- 2.1 All entries to be lodged with the Event Director by the time stipulated on the invitation to enter the competition. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 2.2 All entrants must be financial Members of the AJDC and the entrant must own the vehicle.
- 2.3 All vehicles entered and eligible for any award must be SS, SS Jaguar, Jaguar or Daimler badged derivatives of Jaguars and replicas powered by Jaguar manufactured engines.
- Judges for the event will be appointed by the Event Director and the Club President or his/her delegate.
- Judges who have entered their own car or cars in the Competition shall not participate in the judging of their car/cars.
- 2.6 Each judge has the sole right to assess and award points for his/her particular section.
- 2.7 The decision of the judging panel (which includes the Event Director) is final.
- 2.8 AREAS JUDGED: Engine compartment, interior, exterior, boot, wheels and tyres, lights.
- 2.9 Late arrival for Judging if a vehicle is not in place for judging by the designated time for commencement of judging, the matter will be referred to the Event Director who may exercise his/her discretion and deduct up to 10 points from the score achieved. The Event Director's decision on this matter shall be final.
- 2.10 Vehicles <u>must</u> have current New Zealand Registration and Warrant of Fitness.
- 2.11 Vehicles may be driven or transported on the public highway to the entry point of the event, but <u>must</u> be driven under their own power to the specific judging area or general Jaguar display location as applicable.



- 2.12 The owner of each vehicle or their delegated assistant must be in attendance while the vehicle is being judged.
- 2.13 All vehicles presented for judging must have their doors, sunroofs and windows closed and all doors, bonnet, boot and interior compartments unlocked. Vehicles of open or drop head coupe configuration must have soft tops erected when presented for judging.
- 2.14 No preparation or cleaning of cars is permitted once judging has commenced.
- 2.15 All vehicles entered in the event must remain in position at the event until the completion of presentation of prizes.

#### 3 **SCORING**

- 3.1 Scoring is performed by inspecting cleanliness and condition, awarding points up to the maximum points available for the particular area or component. Score sheets as per the attached proforma at Annex A.
- 3.2 Age related points of 1 point per year of age following manufacture/first registration anywhere in the world, will be awarded in recognition of the greater challenge in presenting the condition of a car's components, the older the car is.

#### 4 TROPHIES

- 4.1 Perpetual Club owned trophies will be awarded for Overall Winner, Best Saloon, Best Sports Car and People's Choice Awards. Certificates will be presented to Runners-up in each category.
- 4.2 **Overall Winner s**hall be awarded to the vehicle that has the least points deducted for cleanliness & condition.
- 4.3 **Best Saloon and Best Sports Car s**hall be awarded to the vehicle in each category that has the least points deducted for cleanliness & condition.
- 4.4 **A Peoples Choice** award may be made at specific shows where a gathering of Jaguars is on display alongside cars entered in a AJDC Concours competition. In this case a "People's Choice" trophy will be awarded to the Jaguar car on display that secures the most votes by Club members, irrespective of whether that car is entered in the Concourse competition or not.
